



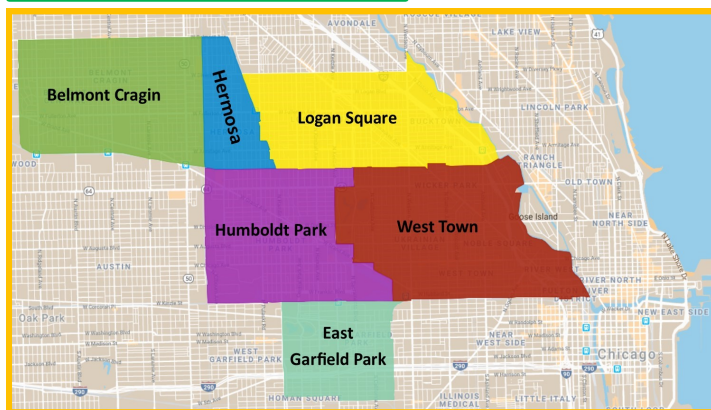
**BRIDGING EMERGENCY FOOD AND COMMUNITY ISSUES
